The little dough man is thought to have originated from the Basel/Neuchatel area of Switzerland. Though his origins are obscure, the grittibanz dates back to at least the 16th century. He is generally thought to represent a simplified Santa Claus (but other views exist).

EVENING WITH SOLISWISS

Followed by a Swiss wine tasting

On Monday October 29, 2007, the Swiss Club of Washington DC facilitated a symposium given by two representatives of Soliswiss under the auspices of the Embassy of Switzerland. Our President, Adrian Wiesner gave the welcome address.

Dr. Felix Bossert, Executive Vice-Chairman, and Dr. Doron Zimmermann, Political Risk Advisor of Soliswiss gave a presentation of their Institution. Soliswiss is the Cooperative Solidarity Fund for Swiss Nationals Abroad. With 50 years of experience, Soliswiss, backed by the Swiss government, offers Swiss security to the 650,000 Swiss national abroad for an annual membership fee of CHF 40. It is a private institution that enables Swiss expatriates to live a financially secure life abroad. Soliswiss also provides mutual financial assistance in case of a loss of livelihood abroad.

In an attempt to make Soliswiss better known in the US, The Swiss Review is printing an interview with Dr. Doron Zimmermann on the subject of political risk cover for Swiss nationals abroad in its next issue. In particular, The Swiss nationals domiciled in and around Washington are encouraged to contact their own representatives for further information as well as visit: www.soliswiss.ch .

After the informative meeting, the members of the Swiss Club enjoyed a lovely Swiss wine tasting accompanied by delicious cheese and hors d'oeuvre of all sorts prepared by our wonderful cook and also Program Coordinator Susann Kollmar.
