The AHPS will meet at the NAPEX postage stamp show the **first weekend in June**. Other show attractions include a booth for children, stamp dealers selling a variety of collectibles, and a first day ceremony of a new United Nations postage stamp (11 am on Friday).

Excursion to Historic Fells Point in Baltimore Waterfront.

This year Fahrt ins Blaue takes us to **historic Baltimore**, a city rich in history including both the War of 1812 and the Civil War. Specifically, the Fells Point ship builders produced the fast schooners and privateers that held the Royal Navy.

Program

9:00am is departure from the Swiss Embassy in Washington DC for thouse who will carpool **10:20am** we will meet at Fells Point Visitors Center at 1724 Thames St. in Baltimore for those who may choose to come directly to Baltimore.

10:30am - 12 noon

A 90 minute historic tour entitled the 'Secrets of a Seaport' given by the Town crier, author and historian of Fells Point. It costs \$9 per adult, kids free.

12:30pm - 2:00pm

The group will board the water taxi (tickets are \$10 and are valid for the day.) to a crab feast at the famous Captain James Landing Marina at 2127 Boston, Baltimore, 21231, for a traditional Baltimore Cuisine. The crab feast options range from \$38 to \$54 for All-You-Can-Eat steamed crabs, Barbecued baby back ribs, Maryland crab soup, fresh steamed corn on cob, etc. Other meal options will also be available at the Marina.

2:15pm to the end

Options to visit the rest of the 13 scenic stops of the water Taxi around the Baltimore harbor like Fort McHenry (of the War of 1812 and near where the national anthem 'Star's Spangled Banner', etc.
