This novel tells the story of a German-Jewish lawyer who is forced into exile in Cuba to escape the Nazi regime. In 1947, he returns to Germany, a country that finds itself in full transition from total disaster to reconstruction


Critics claim that Krechel's narrative effortlessly interweaves historical fact with imaginative fiction, her meticulous research never detracting from the heartrending story of personal and professional loss. The Frankfurter Allgemeine Zeitungs concludes that this is "the most beautiful and at the same time the most ambiguous German novel of this autumn."
