2019 Swiss Rifles Picnic - September 8, 2019

We invite members and their guests to our annual picnic with the Swiss Rifles in Thurmont, MD for food, fun, and festivities. We will have a BBQ, shooting lessons (beginners welcome), and a shooting contest.

Shooting

We will have a shooting contest with prizes! Participants will fire with the Swiss rifle (Karabiner 31) with electronic scoring, 300 yard range and small caliber shooting (children and teens ages 8 to 18), 50 yard range.

Those that wish to participate in shooting will be assigned to a team. Since there are five 300M targets, each team will be comprised of 5 people (a parent will be asked to accompany any child under 18). Each team will have a time slot (roughly 1/2 hour) for shooting. Each participant will be paired up with a preceptor to monitor their shooting, answer questions and manage the weapon. Children and teens that wish to shoot .22LR will shoot on paper. At the conclusion of each team's shooting, we will declare the line "cold" and we will collect the small bore targets for scoring and as a souvenir for the participants.

Rules will be explained by Swiss Rifles members to each team at the Pavillion prior to their time slot and before they go to the range. Shooting will take place only with instruction and supervision by expert Swiss Rifles Members. For your comfort, please wear regular outdoor clothing and closed toe shoes since the shooters stand or sit on wooden chairs. Please bring your own sunglasses or goggles. Ear plugs will be provided.

Please note:

Children must be accompanied and supervised by a parent at all times, at picnic area, playground and shooting rage. No child under the age of 8 will be allowed near the shooting ranges. Ear protection must be worn before approaching shooting ranges.

Ammunition cost is \$6 for 10 rifle shots.


